### **SEPTEMBER'S GUEST SPEAKER**

September's guest speaker, **GWEN BRAGG**, is a well-known watercolor artist in the Washington, D.C. area. In addition to teaching at the Art League School in Alexandria and at the Workhouse Art Center in Lorton (where she has a studio), Gwen holds annual fall workshops at Rehoboth Beach, DE, and spring workshops in Orkney Springs, VA. Gwen has also led international painting workshops almost every year since 1995 to "some place with interesting architecture, artifacts and rocks" including Croatia, Greece, Italy, Spain and Peru.

Gwen will show us how to create textures in watercolor, a technique used in Gwen's Stone-on-Stone series. It is her own adaptation of a technique she discovered in a master class under Lee Weiss.

Paint is applied to both sides of the paper while working on a large sheet of Plexiglas. Flipping the paper over and over mixes colors and creates textures unique to this process and particularly appropriate for depicting timeworn architecture.

Her work has been exhibited in many international, national and regional shows and is included in the collections of NIH, Philip Morris, and James Madison University, among others. ### **WATERCOLOR WORKSHOPS AT THE ART LEAGUE**

**Carolyn Grossé Gawarecki**  
**Sept. 15 (Wed.) and 16 (Thur.) Painting Fall Landscapes**

Wed. 15 Artists will paint a scene of fall trees using yellow as the dominant color plus the compliment violet.

Thur. 16 Artists will paint a different scene of fall trees using red as the dominant color plus the compliment green.

We will talk about color, color compliments, how to paint the fall woods with interesting trees, grasses and other subjects in a fall scene. We will try to create an overall mood of the lush color of fall. We will work wet in wet, using a gator board to staple the painting onto. Bring regular watercolor equipment and several pieces of rough or cold press 140# D'arches. watercolor paper. Bring all the yellows you have, especially raw sienna, new gamboge and winsor yellow. Bring the reds you have such as Alizarin crimson, winsor red, cad. reds and cad.scarlet plus oranges. Bring your

own photos or sketches for reference material. Artists will receive individual attention and there will be a critique at the end of each day.

Dec. 8 & 9 **Painting Snow Scenes**

Wed. 8 Artists will paint snow on a sunny day.

Thur. 9 Artists will paint snow on overcast days and snowing. We will talk about the light on the snow, the color of the shadows as they define snow shapes, and reflected lights on snow. The artists will paint a sunny snow day, and then on the second day paint moody overcast or snowing effects. Bring your regular watercolor supplies and cobalt, winsor, and French ultramarine blues. Bring your own reference material, a gator board, and several pieces of Arches 140# rough or cold press paper. Artists will receive lots of individual attention. There will be a critique each day.

**Painting Mountains Oct. 9 Carolyn Grossé Gawarecki**

The artists will learn to paint mountains in perspective and value. They will learn to express the mass and solidity of a mountain, paint the atmosphere between ranges, and paint snow or rain on the mountains. Bring your normal watercolor art supplies, several sheets of rough or cold press #140 D'arches paper, a container for water and a gator board to work on and a stapler to stretch your paper. Bring your own photos and sketches of mountains to paint also bring a lunch. There will be a demonstration and then the artists will paint while receiving individual help. The session will end with a critique of the work painted.

**DELIVERY:** Saturday, August 28, 2010 between the hours of 10am-12pm or 5pm-7pm at the VAS Art Center. Hanging will be completed Saturday after the Shepherd Center of Oakton Vienna closing reception. Judging will commence during the month by persons visiting the art center. The Center will be open to the public during normal business hours Tuesday- Saturday, 10am-4pm. Thursday, Sept 2nd, there will be an Opening Reception, 6pm-8pm. The show will be hung the month of September, closing Monday, September 27, 2010, 10am-11am pick up.

**SHOW CLOSING:** All unsold artwork must be picked up Monday, September 27<sup>th</sup> between the hours of 10am-11am. Any piece not picked up will incur a \$10/piece/day handling fee.

**STANDARDS: (Questions? Call Teresa Ahmad (571) 277-6202 cell#)**

- This is a judged show. All pieces meeting the following standards will be displayed. Some will receive awards by the judge. Works will be judged based on originality, creativity and technical skill with the medium.
- All forms of mixed media, photography, 3-dimensional work, paintings, and drawings of size and weight easily handled by one or two person are acceptable.
- Work depicting nudes, weapons, or drugs and drug-related items will not be accepted. *Following the VAS By-laws*
- Works must be suitably framed. Frames must be secure and mats clean and well cut. **Framed paintings must have screw eyes and framing wire attached.** NO SAW TOOTH HANGERS. Entries must be dry and ready for handling.
- Size limit 20” x 24” (OR 480 square inches). **If any piece is larger than the size stated will be considered two pieces.**
- Entries consisting of multiple pieces will be considered multiple pieces.
- 3-dimensional work size limit is 12”x12”. If it is a glass or ceramic piece to hang in the window, it needs to be wired and able to fit based on size and weight (ask for more information). If it is a sculpture in which you need a pedestal to display ask for more information- availability is limited.
- Limit Two (2) works of art each for each participant will be accepted. In addition, each participant is welcome to submit two (2) bin pieces with label attached to the back and a filled out 3X5 card with artist, title, and price for our records.
