




MARCH - MEMBERS' THEME SHOW AT THE VAS ART CENTER "WEATHER OR NOT"

HOW TO RESIZE AN IMAGE

It is often necessary to resize images to meet with size requirements. Arla Albers has provided a way to do this without having to learn the complicated programs in Photo Shop. Here is how you can resize pictures.....

Download the free version of Irfanview and resize them....you can get it here:

http://www.irfanview.com
. Then save your picture to your computer. Now open Irfanview and click on file. Then click "open"....Find your picture that you saved on your computer. Click on it and then click "open"....After your picture is up, click on Image....then click Resize/
Resample.....then when that box comes up there should be a place that list Some Standard Dimensions.....then click on 640 X 480 Pixels..(or what ever size you want it to be).....then click ok....that will resize your picture.....then click file.... then "save as" and save on your computer.
Now you are ready to print or send to someone.
