It is fitting that our October featured artist is **Carol Milton**, as she has had a long history with the VAS Gallery. She was the VAS President when the first gallery opened twenty years ago. She later served three times as gallery director. These watercolor paintings are from her photos and sketches of recent trips to the Pacific northwest, Washington, Oregon, and Maine, where the land and seascapes are both dramatic and starkly different in nature. In each watercolor painting the artist has attempted to incorporate the visual experience along with a sense of being there and how it felt at that moment.

Yoshiko shared the story of a little girl who had survived the nuclear bombs that brought World War II to an end. Diagnosed with cancer, she was determined to make 1,000 cranes as she sought healing. When she died before reaching her goal, her classmates completed the mission in her honor.

Jona Blocker of the Workhouse Arts Center presented a hands-on demonstration showing how she has adapted the ancient craft of metal-leafing with modern methods and techniques.
