

NEWS FROM THE VAS GALLERY



Redwoods Remembered by artist Jan Burns was on display through September.

The artist's statement: As a child growing up in Northern California, I was a frequent visitor to the redwood groves that grew near the California coast. These tall, mysterious trees always fascinated me, but as an artist I was always at a loss as to how to portray these magnificent giants on a little piece of paper or canvas. Recently I was inspired to do a series of paintings that focused on the many details of the redwood groves . . . the texture of the bark, the profusion of ferns growing at the base of a the trees, a knothole, and so on. The end result has been a series of semi-abstract ink and watercolor paintings that for me bring back fond memories of these beautiful trees.
